



**UNITED AVIATION (SINGAPORE) PTE LTD**  
**STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS**  
**FOR THE PURCHASE OF PRODUCTS**

Notwithstanding any other provision to the contrary, the following terms and conditions shall apply to any purchase of parts by United Aviation (Singapore) Pte Ltd (Buyer) a company registered in Singapore and having its registered office at 132 Gul Circle, Singapore 629597. Any purchase order issued by the Buyer shall be governed solely by these Terms and Conditions and other written provisions mutually agreed, upon, if any. Any oral understandings are expressly excluded. Buyer shall not be deemed to have waived these Terms and Conditions of Purchase if it fails to object to provisions appearing on, incorporated by reference in, or attached to Seller's Sales Order form which provisions are hereby expressly rejected.

Seller's silence or delivery of parts constitutes its acceptance to these Terms and Conditions. No modification or addition to these Terms and Conditions of Purchase shall be effective unless agreed to in writing and signed by an authorized representative of Buyer.

In the event Buyer order parts from Seller, and Seller delivers parts to Buyer, the terms and conditions contained in this document shall apply to all such purchases and sales transactions.

Delivery shall be made within the time specified on the Buyer's purchase order.

Buyer shall notify Seller of any non-compliance or defect and give the Seller a reasonable opportunity to replace such Parts or credit the Buyer for the purchase price. Seller shall be responsible for all additional costs incurred in the replacement of rejected parts.

All parts shipped to Buyer shall be suitably packed for shipment to prevent damage in transit in accordance to Seller's standard shipping practices.

In addition, Seller shall ensure the following requirements are met:

1. Notify Buyer of any non-confirming product and any changes in product definition.
2. Give right of access by Buyer and Buyer's customers and regulatory authorities to all Seller's facilities involved in this order and to all applicable records.
3. Certification required : Full traceability documentation to Manufacturer Certificate of Conformance, FAA8130-3, EASA Form 1 ( if applicable )
4. Shelf life item must have minimum 80% shelf life remaining.
5. Seek Buyer's approval if alternate or interchangeable part is to be issued.
6. No PMA part is allowed.
7. O-ring / Packing must be individually packed with Certified Ultra-Violet ( UV ) resistant materials, and properly labelled per ARP5316.
8. Quantity shipped must be of zero variance quantity.
9. Quality record retention should be at least 2 years.
10. Obtain Buyer's approval for non-conforming product disposition.
11. Seller shall be fully responsible for the documentation and inspection of products that are drop-shipped directly to Buyer's customer.
